#### THE YIDAKI SOUND IS A DIDGERIDOO!

Did you know that the word 'didgeridoo' actually describes the sound that comes out of the instrument known as the yidaki? Here is a short video of a yidaki being played.

#### Notice:

- Sections where you can hear the beat
- The mainly low pitch of the music because it's a long instrument
- Higher pitched sounds occasionally as the player adjusts the air pressure

#### A FISHING STORY

This video is a story about three generations of

Aboriginal people and how they use their connection to the land and the water to help them with their fishing. Use these questions as discussion points for students after they watch the video.

#### Aboriginal Fishing Story

- 1. Who was the child fishing with (his grandfather)?
- 2. What large sea mammal helped them herd the smaller fish (dolphin)?
- 3. How were these mammals rewarded (fed by the people)?
