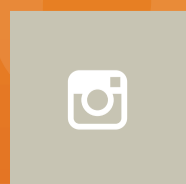
Harmony Day is a day to celebrate our cultural diversity – a day of respect for everyone who calls Australia home. It is supported by the Australian Government Department of Social Services.
